Where to Walk Your Dog

If you decide to walk your dog near the cabin you have rented please be aware that while there is a leash law in Sevier County and the city of Gatlinburg, pets are sometimes allowed to roam freely. This can and does cause conflicts to take place. It is recommended to carry dog repellent just in case your pet has an encounter.

In the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Dogs are allowed in campgrounds, picnic areas, and along roads, but must be kept on a leash at all times. The leash must not exceed 6 feet in length. Dogs are only allowed on one short walking path in the park that is near Gatlinburg — the Gatlinburg Trail which starts at the Sugarlands Welcome Center which is located just inside the National Park at the south end of Gatlinburg on Hwy-441. Pets are not allowed on any other park trails. Pet excrement must be immediately collected by the pet handler and disposed of in a trash receptacle. Pets should not be left unattended in vehicles or RVs.

One area in the park that is a good place for walking your dog is along the road in Greenbrier. There are miles of road that meanders along a beautiful river and has light traffic to deal with. Be sure to follow the Park rules above and park only in designated areas.
